Re: Settlement Conferences in front of Judge Young

Date: June 17, 2020

There is a lot of confusion on this. Until further notice this is the procedure we will be using to get felony matters in front of Judge Young to discuss settlement. If a defense attorney wants a matter calendared they are required to notify the District Attorney's Office (with the case specifics) as to which cases they want to calendar in C-26 to conference with Judge Young. Settlement conferences for the time being will only be set at 1:30, and only on Tuesday and Thursday. A minimum of two days notice will be required. That means no transferring cases from any other courtrooms to C-26 without two days notice. We need this time to prepare the calendar for C-26.

For now, an attorney wanting to calendar a matter in C-26 will be required to notify room 118. We will let room 118 know if this procedure. Utilizing a specific email address, calling the secretaries or JA's is not feasible. Anyone who does will be told of the above procedure.

This is all subject to change once we work out more details and see the need but the above procedure is what we will work with until that time.
