The scholarship will be given to a local law student who has completed at least two years at a Ventura County law school and intends to practice law in the Ventura County area. Priority for the scholarship will be given to those who have a history of local community service, financial need, and those who intend to use their Juris Doctorate to help the local community. The total award amount is up to \$5,000. VCBA's scholarship committee reserves the right to split the \$5,000 award among multiple students or award the entire amount to one student.

- Financial need
- Commitment to public interest work

- **B.** Why did you decide to attend law school? What are your career plans?
- **C.** How did the local community shape your career path?
- **D.** What impact do you intend to make on your local community? How do you plan to do this? What experience do you have with community involvement?

Your essay must be typed in a minimum of 12-point font in Times New Roman, double-spaced, and a maximum of four pages. Essays will be reviewed for thoroughness, clarity, substance, and syntax. Please proofread your essay. Applicants are encouraged to be creative and engaging.

DIRECTIONS FOR SUBMITTING YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION:

- **A.** Compile a complete scholarship application with all of the above materials. Please submit all materials simultaneously. Partial applications will not be considered.
- **B.** You may include 1-3 letters of recommendation.

- **D.** The deadline to submit your scholarship application is 9 a.m. PST on **September 18, 2022**. Late applications will not be considered.
