



#### JUSTICE HERNALDO BALTODANO JOINS DIVISION SIX

The Second District Court of Appeal, Division Six, recently welcomed Justice Hernaldo Baltodano to the bench and he graciously received Barristers Christal Porter and Ben Baumer for an interview intended to get to know him better, not only as a jurist, but as a human being. The meeting inspired and transformed us both.

#### The Person Behind the Robe

Justice Baltodano exudes humility and puts the grit in integrity with a work ethic that routinely sees him in the office before the sun rises. For him, it is a labor of love and reverence for our profession that drives him to serve with diligence, humility, and humanity. When he was an infant, Justice Baltodano and his family immigrated to California in the 1970s, seeking, as he says, "the safety and promise of America." Although they could only provide a modest upbringing because of educational and language limitations, Justice Baltodano's parents raised him to have empathy and compassion for everyone. Those values help Justice Baltodano see the faces behind the cases with the knowledge that litigants "remember how you make them feel." It was clear to us that Justice Baltodano's desire to honor his parents' sacrifices (and those of all hard-working Americans) motivates his pursuit of excellence.

From his years of employment litigation experience at various law firms (2002-2011), to co-founding and growing a thriving plaintiff employment law practice with his attorney wife (2011-2017), to serving as a Superior Court judge and then supervising criminal judge in San Luis Obispo County (2017-2022), Justice Baltodano's legal experience reaches broadly. He not only possesses a voracious appetite for learning and continuing education, Justice Baltodano also devotes many hours to mentoring students, lawyers, and judges from all walks of life. And although he did not mention it during our interview, we learned that Justice Baltodano and his attorney wife have contributed many hours of their legal expertise (pro bono) to serving the most vulnerable and underserved in their communities.

To get a more comprehensive overview of Justice Baltodano's legal and personal

#### The Call to Service

Justice Baltodano joined the bench in 2017, shortly after a very contentious presidential election. During that time, our nation was experiencing extreme political discord and division. Because of the tumultuous political climate, Justice Baltodano became concerned about the toxicity in our public discourse. He believed that serving as a judge would give him the opportunity to create an environment within the judicial branch of our democracy based on respect and civility where all people would be heard. Because of his diverse life experiences and values, Justice Baltodano believed he could make a difference in society by serving as a judge. Justice Baltodano believes that no one should be pigeonholed into having preordained opinions on political issues solely because of party affiliation and labels. Instead, Justice Baltodano values and pursues independent, critical thinking and civil discourse on the pressing issues facing all litigants who come to the courts seeking iustice.

#### Wisdom for Barristers

Below is a summary some of the more salient Q and A from our time with Justice Baltodano:

Q: As a justice, what are your pet peeves?

A: Overwritten and repetitive briefs; personal attacks on opposing counsel are ineffective.

Q: What advice can you provide young attorneys?

A: Practicing law is a learned profession, not just a job. Lawyers are not only zealous advocates for their clients, but ambassadors for our system of justice and democracy. Treat your role as a lawyer and counselor with the respect and awe it deserves. Facilitate access to justice by mentoring

the most needy or vulnerable, or through pro bono work. Take pride in everything you do as a lawyer, and that includes how you treat people. There is a technical part and a relational part to being an effective attorney; being kind and exuding humility is underrated. Do not compromise your values and be mindful in building your brand as a young lawyer. Legal briefs from a lawyer with a good reputation carries weight, especially with the time constraints that bench officers face every day. Integrity, civility, and reliability translate to credibility with the bench.

Q: Do you have a favorite quote or mantra?

A: Things happen for a reason, so don't dwell on the negative. Always do the right thing, especially when no one is watching.

Q: If you could travel to any time in history, who would you like to have a conversation with and why?

A: MLK, Thurgood Marshall, RBG, Jackie Robinson. Courage is important for lawyers and judges. As the first African American to join Major League Baseball, Jackie Robinson faced an incredibly hostile environment. He epitomized courage – not only on the baseball field – but in society at large.

Q: What do you see for the immediate future of Division 6?

A: In the next few months I expect another justice will be confirmed to fill the vacancy left by the retirement of **Justice Steven Perren**. And we will continue to grapple with the remedial criminal justice legislation coming from Sacramento.

#### Gratitude

One theme Justice Baltodano reiterated throughout our interview was his appreciation for his family and colleagues and staff at the Court of Appeal. He feels immeasurably welcomed and supported by his fellow justices, research attorneys, clerks, secretaries, administrative staff, and the care and protection provided by California Highway Patrol.




