

Connecting the dots to get from middle school to being the first in your family to graduate high school, college, or secure a professional degree can be overwhelming and hard to know where to start. This is why programs such as Attorneys Sharing Knowledge ("ASK"), as initiated by recent Past President Jacquelyn Ruffin, are so important. And this why it was such a great time recently to be part of the team of four who presented to Ms. Christine Simonson's 7th and 8th grade AVID classes on being a lawyer and other careers in the law. I was so happy to be on the panel with Efan Wu, defense attorney at the Ventura County Public Defender's Office, Kristine Tijam, of Procter, Shyer & Winter, LLP, and our own wonderful Sandra Rubio, Executive Director of the Ventura County Bar Association.

The students themselves asked a wide range of questions, everything from clarifying questions about Breaking Bad and Better Call Saul to how much the bar exam costs.

I think we may have even surprised one another with the broad range of experience – Sandra as a mediator and director of a non-profit professional association, Efan as a government employee and criminal trial attorney, Kristine as a litigation assistant and claims adjuster, graduate of Colleges of Law and now civil litigator, and me as the owner of a small, community-based firm representing immigrant families

and survivors of violence and advising local policy advocates and individuals on advocating for their rights. Over the two short class periods, we felt the students become inspired and more clear-eyed regarding the range of law-related jobs they might aspire to. We look forward to seeing them apply for internships with various firms and agencies, volunteer at events such as Swap Meet Justice and participate in extracurriculars such as Mock Trial or Speech and Debate. Our group agreed, we look forward to being able to work with students in this way again many times in the future, as well as working with our other colleagues at the Bar, sharing our experiences and tips for success with the next generation.



BARRISTERS' CORNER: ADUS VS. "HIGH FIRE HAZARD ZONE" RESTRICTIONS

California is experiencing both a housing crisis and an increased prevalence of wildfires.

In an attempt to address California's housing crisis, the state has enacted legislation to promote the development of accessory dwelling units ("ADUs") and reduce local governments' control over such developments. (Gov. Code, § 65850, et seq..) As a result, a battle is unfolding over the state's demand for more housing and local governments' desire to protect residents from fire-related disasters.

Government Code section 65852.2, subdivision (a)(1)(A) provides local governments with some limited ability to restrict the locations of ADUs within their boundaries. Local agencies have the power to "[d]esignate areas ... where accessory dwelling units may be permitted[,]" and "[t]he designation of areas may be based on ... the impact of accessory dwelling units on traffic flow and public safety."

Many local governments have used this "impact on traffic flow and public safety" language to support land use codes that restrict ADUs in areas subject to increased fire risks. Proponents of these restrictions argue that, among other things, they are necessary to prevent an increase in traffic jams and evacuation difficulties during wildfires.

For example, section 9283.2 of the City of Agoura Hills Municipal Code provides that "[w]here a lot or any portion thereof is located within a very high fire hazard severity zone, only one (1) ADU or [junior ADU] shall be permitted on the lot unless the lot has two (2) distinct means of vehicular access"

San Buenaventura Municipal Code section 24.430.040.C states that "no ADUs shall be permitted in areas within designated Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones; however, [junior ADUs] are allowed."

Recently, the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD"), the agency charged with reviewing local ADU ordinances (Gov. Code, § 65852.2, subd. (h)), has pushed back on these types of wildfire based ADU restrictions.

In Jan. 2022, the City of Berkeley adopted an ADU ordinance that prohibited more than one ADU or junior ADU in areas the city designated as "Very-High Fire Hazard Severity Zones." (Berkeley Municipal Code § 12.99.030.) The City relied on a 2021 UC Berkeley traffic simulation that analyzed a hypothetical wildfire evacuation in the Berkeley Hills to support the proposition that more residential units in this area could negatively impact traffic and public safety. The HCD responded:

[W]hile the HCD is sympathetic to concerns about fire safety and the need to ensure adequate evacuation in the event of a fire, the City has not adequately demonstrated that new ADUs will actually impact public safety in the [Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone]. The traffic simulation study is not specific to ADUs and [junior ADUs], and therefore the information and conclusions do not adequately justify the restriction of ADUs in the Hillside Overlay District per Government Code 65852.2, subdivision (a)(1)(A).

In similar circumstances playing out in the town of Portola Valley, an HCD Housing Policy Analyst emailed Portola Valley representatives stating:

... The CalFire maps that establish High Fire Hazard Zones may impact building design standards (such as required building materials) and have no impact on areas where ADUs may be permitted.

... [T]he City may not curtail ADU creation by ordinance promulgated pursuant to authority granted in Government Code section 65852.2, subdivision (a)(1)(A) based on the impact of ADUs on public safety without evidence provided to HCD for HCD to determine the City's compliance with the statute.

Although the HCD has taken the position that these fire-related ADU restrictions are largely impermissible under Government Code Section 65852.2(a)(1)(A), there do not appear to be any published cases that analyze this issue.

Stay tuned – as we are likely to see the courts weigh in as this battle wages on.
