



HAVE YOU HEARD



David Joseph Olivas, 63, passed away on September 29. David earned his BA from Harvard University, then earned his Juris Doctor degree from the UCLA School of Law. After graduation, he served as a Judicial Law Clerk for the Hon. David W. Williams of the United States District Court, Central District of California. He was president of Latinx Ventura Chapter. He was an active member of the Montalvo Community Council and Ventura Chamber of Commerce. He was also the co-chair of the Public Safety Racial Equity Advisory Group.



John Francis Scoles, 82, passed away on August 16. John served in the US Army at the Presidio in San Francisco, and in Japan from 1966-1968. He graduated from McGeorge School of Law. After passing the Bar, he joined the office of Joseph P.D. Kern, and then Arthur Taylor, for nearly 40 years in the practice of law in what eventually became Taylor, Scoles, and Bartels. He is a former past president of the Fillmore Chamber of Commerce and Rotary International and was very pleased to be elected to the Fillmore High School Sports Hall of Fame and the OSU 1963 Team Hall of Fame.



The UC Santa Cruz Foundation has elected six new trustees who are established leaders across a range of industries, from fiber optics and scientific operations to media, arts, and community service. Ventura County attorney **Panda Kroll** has been elected to join the Foundation Board of Trustees. Panda defends attorneys and other consumer advocates in federal lawsuits throughout the country in lawsuits brought by timeshare developers who seek to enjoin those advocates' efforts in assisting timeshare owners burdened with unlawful and/or unconscionable "in perpetuity" timeshare contracts.



On October 18, 2023, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the appointment of Ventura Superior Court Commissioner **Paul William Feldman** to a judgeship in the Ventura Superior Court. The appointment authorizes Judge Feldman to begin his judicial duties immediately. Judge Feldman fills the vacancy created by the elevation of **Justice Tari Cody** to the Court of Appeal earlier this year.

Prior to his appointment, Judge Feldman served as court commissioner beginning on July 5, 2022, and, in that capacity, he heard misdemeanor and traffic arraignments and trials, small claims trials, juvenile traffic/truancy, guardianships and expungement matters.



Ventura County Community Foundation ("VCCF") will start accepting scholarship applications for the **J. Roger Myers** Scholarship Fund on November 6, 2023. Applications close on January 19, 2024. Applications can be found at VCCF's website https://vccf.org/scholarships. VCFF awards the scholarship in May 2024. However, the \$5,000.00 scholarship is "officially" awarded on an ongoing, yearly basis at the Ventura County Bar Association's annual Installation and Awards dinner that occurs every November.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must be residents of Ventura County who are enrolled at any law school in the United States. Students must intend to return and practice law in Ventura County. Preference in the selection process will be given to military veterans or those currently in the military. There is also a specially required essay of 300-500 words for the applicant to explain how they intend to use their law degree to benefit the local Ventura County legal community. These eligibility requirements honor J. Roger Myers' military service and his dedication to serving the local community throughout his 52-year legal career.

If anyone knows of any law student who is a resident of Ventura County and meets all the other criteria set forth above, please encourage them to apply.



KAREN OAKMAN - 2023 BEN E. NORDMAN PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD RECIPIENT

Karen Oakman is the 2023 recipient of the Ventura County Bar Association's Ben E. Norman Public Service Award. Oakman selflessly dedicates an immense amount of time to the service of others in her community, through her involvement in community organizations and public service projects.

Oakman is a family law and criminal defense attorney and has been practicing since 2010. She shares her legal expertise and philanthropic spirit with numerous local organizations.

Dedication to Public Service

Conejo Free Clinic (CFC) is a nonprofit organization that provides free medical, dental, and legal assistance to qualifying Conejo Valley residents. CFC has been a great benefactor of Oakman's endless energy, resourcefulness, and belief in access to justice for all. Oakman works with clients, recruits new volunteer attorneys for the clinic's legal team, and raises awareness within the legal community. In 2017, Oakman began volunteering with CFC, joined its board of directors, then became its legal director. Oakman was CFC's secretary from 2018 through 2021, and 2023, and she served as CFC's president in 2022-2023.

CFC volunteers Corliss Krivoy and Susan Drapkin have commented, "Thanks to

Karen, the number of legal specialties offered by the CFC has vastly increased to meet the increasingly significant need of the community. And ultimately, many of the CFC legal clients have expressed great appreciation for the services they received." In fact, during Covid, the clinic was in danger of closure due to health concerns, but Oakman solved the problem by pivoting to virtual client/attorney appointments, thereby keep the clinic running for those who needed it most.

Dedication to Leading

Oakman also never shies away from taking leadership positions. Women Lawyers of Ventura County has benefitted from her active involvement since 2019. She has held the positions of board secretary, vice chair, and president. This year, as immediate past president, she volunteered her knowledge and time to keep the nonprofit running smoothly. "Karen is a phenomenal inspiration. Her work on Women Lawyer's events throughout the years has been vital. She is always someone you can count on to volunteer for tasks, and she reliably gets things done" says current WLVC President Lauren Nicholson.

Oakman has also served on the board of the Ventura County Family Law Bar Association since 2017, when she first became a member. Since then, she has acted as their treasurer (2017-2018) and their vice president (2019).

The Ventura County Diversity Bar Alliance also enjoys Oakman's spirit of inclusivity and acceptance of all. She has been a board member with the Alliance since 2022 and served as its Co-President with Dien Le in 2022. Le says "When I was Co-Chair of the Ventura County Diversity Bar Alliance last year, Karen (representing WLVC) was actively involved in helping us organize many of our successful events. She consistently attended all our meetings, and was always willing to volunteer her efforts. So naturally when it came time to choose a successor co-chair for this year, she was our first choice. Karen is so deserving of the Nordman Award, and we are thrilled to see her being honored for her tireless service to the community."

Dedication to Mentoring

On top of her local volunteer and board involvement, Oakman also works as an adjunct professor. California Lutheran University (CLU) has been lucky enough to have her since 2015, where she teaches criminal law and procedure and constitutional law for the University's criminal justice department. From 2017 to 2019 she served as CLU's pre-law coordinator. Oakman mentors her college students, which includes bringing them to court to see what being a lawyer is really like

Oakman, a CLU alumna herself, has supervised several interns through CLU's Pre-Law program. 2022 CLU intern, Mia Deck, says "Karen is a great mentor for future law school students. While interning for her, she showed us and taught us a lot about the procedural processes of the legal field. She also serves as a good role model by using her profession to help others such as her volunteer work at the free clinic. We love Karen!"

Dedication to Community

Oakman does all this while maintaining her own family law and criminal defense practice. In 2020, Oakman launched Clunen and Oakman Law, LLP with her colleague and friend **Kathryn Clunen**. She has been named a Super Lawyer since 2022. If you're lucky, you can see her zealously advocating for her clients in court with her bright yellow briefcase.

Oakman's compassionate, kind, and generous spirit exemplifies the best in what attorneys can offer. "I am honored to receive this year's Ben E. Nordman award. I am also excited this may bring additional attention to the Conejo Free Clinic, which does such important work," says Oakman.




the Parent Teacher Association (PTA). She has been the PTA parliamentarian from 2020 to 2022 and is currently the secretary for the school years 2022-2024.

any jurisdiction for a period of seven (7) years or less; or (iii) has been in practice in any jurisdiction for a total of (7) years or less. Active law students who are members of the Ventura County Bar Association are considered "Student Barristers" and may serve on the Board as a Member at Large, but may not serve as an officer of the Board.

WOMEN LAWYERS' ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP DINNER DELIGHTS

Women Lawyers of Ventura County held its fifteenth annual Scholarship Dinner and Silent Auction on October 3, 2023, at the Onyx Bistro in Camarillo.

The first awards were given to law students **Melinda Khachaturian** and McKenna Fitzpatrick. Khachaturian is in her third year at the Santa Barbara and Ventura Colleges of Law, and she spoke passionately about her background as a mental health advocate. Fitzpatrick is in her third year at Pepperdine University Caruso School of Law. She currently serves as a certified law clerk at the District Attorney's office.

The Holly Spevak Award, which is given to a member of the legal community who has increased access to justice through pro bono legal service, was presented to attorney **Carolyn Tulberg**, whose tireless dedication to the Ventura Legal Aid Clinic and other volunteer endeavors make her the ideal example of giving back to the community. And, everyone was thankful that she made it to the dinner on time; she double-checked that the event didn't conflict with her volunteer commitment earlier that afternoon.

Finally, the Legacy Award, given to a member of the community at large who has significantly contributed to the advancement of the aims and rights of women and girls in society, was awarded to attorney and keynote speaker **Jody Moore**. As a senior partner at Johnson-Moore, Moore developed a passion for advocating against elder abuse. She and her partner **Greg Johnson** received the first civil elder abuse verdict in Ventura County in 2002. She has continuously leveled-up her practice since then.

In 2021, she and two other female trial attorneys tried a complex cluster case to verdict in Alameda County. The case was tried entirely by Zoom. It lasted four months, involved 10 plaintiffs, and resulted in a \$14.5 million dollar verdict, including punitive damages. The trial team was recognized as the San Francisco Trial Lawyer of the Year, and Moore herself was the first woman ever to receive Ventura County Trial Lawyer of the Year recognition. Her impact is seen not only in what she does for her clients and in the courtroom, but in her ability to model for other women how

they can balance the practice of law with also leading fulfilling lives.

Past presidents enjoyed each other's company, and silent auction items were bid on and taken home. The Raw Honey Band provided wonderful music. The well-attended event raised money for scholarships and for continued outreach in the community.


