#### WE READ, SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO

On knowing when "enough is enough."

"A bulldozer can move piles of dirt from one place to another. But when the goal is to move minds rather than dirt, employing a bulldozer may be counterproductive. The bulldozer in this case is appellant Debra Wear's counsel. In our prior nonpublished opinion, *Tedesco v. White* (June 15, 2022, G059883, 2022 WL 2155962) (*Tedesco 1*), we made clear to these lawyers that "[w]e do not confuse aggressive argument with persuasive advocacy." Although the aggression has not abated, our view of it remains unchanged."

California's Fourth District Court of Appeal (Div. 3) began its recent decision in *Tedesco v. White* with these words of wisdom. The case involved – at least on the surface – a challenge to an order of discovery sanctions in the amount of \$6,000. Wear's counsel used the sanctions challenge as a platform to attack the merits

of the trial court's *nonappealable* underlying order quashing Wear's document subpoena, and then used the trial court's analysis underlying *that* discovery ruling into a basis for reviewing a separate order the Court had already ruled cannot be appealed. The Court found Wear's "broader quest" was to "again collaterally attack the validity of a conservatorship over the estate of Thomas S. Tedesco, which was established in the probate court in Riverside County in 2015." In furtherance of that goal, Wear's counsel presented the appellate court with an appendix in excess of 9,000 pages.

The decision is an interesting read that, among other things, distinguishes the appealability of discovery *sanctions* orders with related *discovery* orders. The former is appealable; the latter is not. ["When reviewing an appealable sanctions order, we review the merits of related orders only to

the extent necessary to resolve the challenge to the appealable monetary sanctions."]

In explaining that the attack on the probate matter had already been repeatedly rejected by both the probate court and the appellate court in Riverside County, and elsewhere, the Court opined: "Counsel's dogged refusal to acknowledge these losses (other than by disparaging some of the courts involved) changes nothing..."




