

CITATIONS Managing Editor Profile: Kathleen Maheu

Kathleen ("Kat") Maheu has been serving as the Managing Editor for the Ventura County Bar Association's CITATIONS magazine since July 2023. Maheu stepped into the role previously held by Wendy Lascher, who had been at the helm of CITATIONS for many years, most recently co-editing with Cari Ann Potts. Lascher has made (and continues to make) lasting and indelible contributions to our local legal community, and beyond as a well-known appellate attorney. Maheu knows she has "big shoes to fill" and hopes her contributions to CITATIONS and VCBA will live up to Lascher's legacy.

Career Background

Maheu received her associate degree in journalism from Los Angeles Valley College. At LAVC, Maheu was involved in every aspect of the campus newspaper, The Valley Star, from a column writer to Editor in chief, and every position in between. Maheu found time to devote to her journalism studies and newspaper duties while also playing on LAVC's intercollegiate women's softball team for two years. Maheu successfully juggled both of her passions until her last semester before graduation. Her love of softball and the wear and tear it caused on her shoulder forced her to turn down a post degree offer with the Los Angeles Daily News sports department. Maheu had to undergo an intensive surgical procedure on her right shoulder to repair tendon and tissue damage from her rigorous play as a first baseman.

After her shoulder surgery recovery, Maheu transferred to California State University, Northridge and found herself working with DHL, a global logistics and shipping company, where she started as a part time pickup/delivery driver while attending her junior year at CSUN. She soon found herself rising in the ranks until she ultimately held a position as a major account executive in DHL's sales division, a promotion that came while she was going to law school. Maheu moved to Ventura in 1997 as part of a promotion/transfer at DHL. During her time climbing the ranks at DHL, Maheu managed to complete her bachelor's degree from CSUN in Political Science, taking night classes for many years. (Maheu's original major was Biology - Pre Med, but after observing the same shoulder surgery she had undergone, Maheu realized the surgeon path was not for her.)

After achieving success with DHL, Maheu wanted more of an intellectual challenge in her work, so she enrolled at Ventura College of Law and attended the night program while she still worked at DHL. During her studies at VCL, Maheu was a student in several of Mark Pachowicz's criminal law classes and subsequently worked as a law clerk for his private practice while she awaited bar results in 2008. Upon passing the bar exam, Pachowicz hired Maheu full-time as an associate attorney with the understanding she would work primarily in family law. From the time she was licensed until August 2023, Maheu worked for Pachowicz' firm, The Law Offices of Mark Pachowicz, which became Pachowicz Goldenring following a 2020 merger.

Throughout her career, Maheu has concentrated her practice in family law while also providing litigation support in criminal defense, civil litigation, federal civil rights actions, and a variety of other subpractice areas for the firm. In August 2023, Maheu embarked on a new phase of her career, accepting a position with the Ventura County Superior Court as Court Research Attorney. Maheu utilizes her extensive civil litigation background and passion for learning to assist judicial officers.

Q & A

-What are some notable cases that you worked on during your time as a civil litigator?

There are a number of memorable cases, but one that comes to mind is *Willis v Vasquez, et al.* This was a civil rights lawsuit tried in the U.S. District Court of California, Central Division. I was able to play a major role in the pretrial work and at trial I was the evidence technician, responsible for marshalling and displaying the exhibits to everyone in the courtroom. The case is notable because it was the first case where a jury awarded punitive damages against the Los Angeles County Sheriff, Lee Baca. The case centered around the physical abuse and unjust beating of an inmate by Los Angeles Sheriff Department correctional officers.

What do you appreciate about your new position as Legal Research Attorney with the Ventura Superior Court?

I enjoy the opportunity to review matters from a neutral standpoint and assess both sides of the matter without the emotional drama of litigation. I also appreciate learning and understanding the law that centers around a case and using my litigation background to understand the nuances of the many different types of cases I see, from lemon law cases to medical malpractice, to business disputes. My job is to help consolidate information/facts/issues for the judges. I have experienced that our Ventura Superior Court judges are earnestly committed to doing right by the parties that appear before the Court.

What are your duties as Managing Editor of Citations?

As managing editor, I act as the "last filter" for CITATIONS. I edit and perform the final review of articles and content in the magazine. I also chair the monthly CITATIONS Editorial Board meetings and work closely with the VCBA office to plan upcoming articles and focal points for CITATIONS.

What are your thoughts about the current state of Citations and your hopes for the future of the magazine?

I appreciate that CITATIONS is our "local" magazine where the Ventura County legal community can stay connected and informed about local updates, VCBA subgroup events, and get to know colleagues and judicial officers. Ventura County is sometimes thought of to be a "small town" and CITATIONS plays an integral part in keeping everyone in the Ventura legal community connected.

I am hopeful that the magazine can move towards including more legal content and discussion of interesting appellate level cases that impact our legal community. I also want to be responsive to what the readers want to read, so I would like to pose the question: What would you like to see in CITATIONS? All input and feedback is welcome. Ventura County will soon have many open positions in the judiciary, and Governor Gavin Newsom's office will eventually be looking to fill these spots. There has never been a more exciting time to apply for this rewarding career. But do you understand the application process?

If you think a career as a judge may be your future, or if you would just like to learn more about the application process, I invite you to attend the upcoming virtual workshop, "The Bench is Calling... Will YOU Heed to the Call?" The program is a workshop from the Tri-Counties Judicial Mentor Program.

The Tri-Counties Judicial Mentorship Program is a collaboration between the executive and judicial branches of the State of California. The program was formed in 2021 with the goal of recruiting and developing a highly qualified judicial applicant pool that reflects California's rich diversity. A diverse judicial applicant pool includes a diverse set of practice areas and backgrounds, as well as diverse ethnicities, sexual orientations, and nationalities.

The Judicial Mentorship Program is looking to increase awareness of the judicial needs in Ventura, Santa Barbara, and San Luis Obispo Counties while providing support to prospective candidates.
